Erich Segal's Doctor's novel, published in 1973, is a comic fictionalization of a real story; while reading it we find ourselves (unintentionally) playing the role of the psychiatrist, as we think about Dr. Livingston's fate as a patient at the hands of Dr. Braunschweig. Are we "living" this novel in Dr. Braunschweig's office, witnessing his treatment of Barney Livingston, or are we inside Livingston's head, as he thinks about his experience? Either way, we're observing the story, as well as Livingston. The novel is structured in a fairly predictable but not slavishly-written way: there is a flashback to Livingston's life in the past, a description of his daily activities, and a summary of each of his sessions with Dr. Braunschweig. But this structure is not at all a device to tie the reader's hands. We are still required to identify with Livingston, and to observe all the little things that make him up. We are, in short, required to empathize with the character and his situation. The story line follows Livingston, from his arrival at the hospital, to his confession, to his release and comfortable retirement. It is a story about a man who becomes a "doctor" after a career in the theatre. It's about a man who goes crazy after a blow to the head, and it's about the comically inept efforts of a psychiatrist to try to fix him. It's about a man who goes to the hospital in the first place because he feels responsible for the death of his brother, who had leukemia and died at the age of nine. And it's about the magical occurrences that take place when a man who thinks he's dead for ten years suddenly finds himself back in life. Most doctors I know are pompous, or self-satisfied, or both. Dr. Braunschweig is not a doctor like any of the ones I've known. He doesn't play one on TV, and he's certainly not a rocket surgeon, or a fighter pilot, or a medical researcher, or a heart surgeon. He's a doctor of sorts, but he doesn't even pretend to have all the answers. He's our guide into the area of mental health, and also the incarnation of a fantasy--the overlooked, 2d92ce491b
