would like to recover my Profile and I am using the same password I use to login to my computer. I tried it in the Link but it is asking me for another password which I don't have, but I did use that one. I would like to know if there is any way to recover my User Profile or if it is lost forever. A: If you set your passwords to the same value as the Active Directory passwords then you will be logged in to your account when the backup is run. So you will need to decide if the value of the password to log you

in with is important. It would be safe to change the password (or at least the one used to log in) to something else. Q: Looking to make a python script that does only one thing I was looking for a program that runs on Linux, Mac or Windows, that would run on any of them and simply lists the network interfaces available on the machine and the IP address of each one. I found a few options online but they all seem to be quite complicated (trying to do the same thing on Windows involves running a whole bunch of

batch files and I'm hoping I can just run a single.py script). I was wondering if anyone knew of something simple that would do this job? A: The -I option of the ip command is what you want. It's the same as the -A option on ifconfig. If you want to get all available interfaces (including loopback and null interfaces), run: ip -A If you just want the non-loopback interfaces: ip -A -n If you want the raw output, then add -o to get just the address. You can also pipe it into your favorite text editor: ip -A -n
